"Dumpster Policy"

The City Code Chapter 105.10.05, states dumpsters are available to rent at a rate of \$15.00 per week. The week runs Wednesday through Tuesday. Dumpsters may only be kept for up to two (2) weeks at a time per property. The City of Grand Mound has implemented this Dumpster Policy to set regulations regarding dumpster placement, limits, delivery, no delivery, and unaccepted items.

Placement: Dumpsters shall be placed in the boulevard by the public works department and need to remain in the position placed to avoid the dumpster needing to be moved once filled. It is the responsibility of the property owner or person requesting the dumpster to ensure the dumpster is in the same place and facing the same direction originally placed at the time it is emptied by the city. If it is not in the correct position, and cannot be emptied the property will still be charged \$15.00 for having the dumpster that week. Dumpster placement in an alley shall be at the discretion of the public works department based on conditions of the alley.

Limit: A limit of two (2) dumpsters per property, for a maximum of two weeks in a row.

Special Events: A request for more than 2 dumpsters for a special event for a commercial or community event is subject to approval as long as the number of dumpsters requested is available.

Delivery: Dumpsters are delivered on Tuesday or Wednesday depending on the public works department's schedule. Dumpster requests received during the week are delivered the following week on Tuesday or Wednesday.

No Dumpster Delivery List: Properties and owner's/tenants who have placed unaccepted items in a dumpster will be given one written warning about unacceptable waste. A second offense will result in the property address and person requesting the dumpster being placed on a no dumpster delivery list for violation of this policy.

Unaccepted Items: Concrete, Bricks, Electronics, Appliances, Oil/Antifreeze, Yard waste, Chemicals, Paint, Tires, TVs, Medical Sharps, Fluorescent lights. A sign is on each dumpster showing this list as well.
